Wasn't it enough to lose my parents 7 months apart but then to take my husband home so suddenly about a year later? During those 2 years I lost 9 close relatives including Keith and my parents. My uncle was found dead when after someone went looking for him because he didn't show up at Keith's funeral.

I found comfort in this verse as well as the people who around me. I realized my mom would have been a vegetable had she lived and I was blessed to be with her when she died. My dad was just not the same after losing my mom, he was a shell of the man he use to be gone was the dad I knew -the man of steel. He died next to my mom's urn. I believe they met each other in heaven and so happy to be together. "Broken heart syndrome" is a real thing. I have a little harder time with Keith but I do remember him telling me he was tired. So very tired. When writing his obituary I realized that he had touched so many lives and helped so many people. He lives on in others because I made the decision to donate his corneas, connective tissues and skin. He was still touching other lives. When I feel down as I do some days and memories seem overwhelming I remember to pray-not why me but to say thank you for letting them be in my life as long as they have. I know God has a plan and one day I will find out what it is but until then I remember this verse:

"Seek the Lord and his strength; seek his presence continually"

If you feel your faith being tested or things aren't going your way just remember the Lord is with you E - V - E - R - Y *step of the way through your life. God doe snot punish ; he blesses.*


Care & Concern Team

Changes in Income ; Vida Racine left in February 2020, COVID pandemic hit in March so Offering was way down.

Expenses: Paid just the interest due on the Boilers to LACE loan, In May to help with loss of money Pastor Heather asked for a furlough and that she just gets paid as a supply pastor.

OFFICE REPORT - Compete as written

MEMBERSHIP REPORT—looks good because we counted the facebook and youtube views as well. (Synod required on Congregational Report)

PROPERTY REPORT - Shingles blew off the roof from time to time during 2020. Local roofers either didn't charge for the repair or they charged very little. A homeless couple ws found to be living in the window well under Pastors office. The police were notified and they asked them to leave the property.

THREAD by THREAD REPORT — Complete as written

MEMORIAL REPORT—No outlays—have planned to use for the organ. Only need congregational approval if over 5K. Cur rent monies available—12-14K

LACE REPORT - Recommendations for 2020 LACE Outlays, Scholarship: Hunter Berterman. Non Profit Grants: Our Harmony Club and Senior Companion Program.

SEGREGATED FUNDS REPORT -

LACE Fund has 321K and has grown since the report was written.

MOTION made by Leo and Seconded by Kelly to accept the reports as written. Motion Passed with voice vote. 38 l's, 0 - Nays, 0 - abstentions

2021 BUDGET— was read through by Ed, the following highlights were made.

PASTORS BENEFITS: Continue on furlough/supply pastor pay until August 31, 2021. Will resume 1/2 time pay for the last 4 months of the year. (September through December)

OFFERING: Is under what should be.

Ed stated that there is a chart on the bulletin board outside the hearth room that has a graph of our income and expenses if anyone wants to view it.

QUESTIONS ON BUDGET ITEMS:

How often does the RFD visit—quarterly. Fire Extingishers checked—2x a year.

How is the Revenue determined for the budget—It's our best guess based on previous years.

MOTION made by Kelly and seconded to accept the 2021 Budget. Motion Passed with voice vote. 38 I's, 0 - Nays , 0 - abstentions

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR VARIOUS BODIES

COUNCIL: Meets once a month on the first Tuesday. Currently has a 8 members but is allowed 12 so there is 4 openings to fill.

LACE: Has 3 openings. They meet 4x a year. Terms are 3 yr., 2 year and 1 year.

MEMORIAL : Has openings. They meet 2x a year.

PRAYER CHAIN LEADER: 1 opening. Duties are you receive prayer requests from members or the office and you pass them on via email to other prayer chain members.

OLD BUSINESS-

NEW BUSINESS -

- 2—PARTNER WITH ANOTHER CHURCH -share the Pastor
- 3 STAY THE SAME—find another 1/4 or 1/2 time pastor. Not many available for less than fulltime.
- 4—CLOSE THE CHURCH—we would have the ability to choose what happens to our stuff and set our own close date. (Many adamant shouts of NO)
- 5— SHARE A PASTOR WITH ANOTHER CONGREGATION
- 6-KEEP THE ONLINE WORSHIP SERVICE OPTION
- 7-FIND ANOTHER CONGREGATION TO SHARE OUR BUILDING

DISCUSSION—See minutes from the meeting.

CONCENSUS—Seek a partner church and part time pastor. Try growing. Keep the online services. Time change a possibility with advanced notice.

SEEKING TO MAKE AMENDMENTS TO THE CHURCH CONSTITUTION.

- Any amendments will require to congregational votes.




