From the President:

hank you to all members of the Congregation present for the Congregational Meeting on October 24th.

We completed some good work with approving four scholarships and a grant directly impacting our immediate neighborhood. A total of \$5,000 is going out impacting the lives of others. This seemed to be in direct response to our guest pastor's sermon focusing on the question of "What would Christ want us to do?"

The other item of business that was completed was approving the moving ahead with entering into a Covenant Agreement with Pastor Allison Johnson. A lively discussion over all the ways this would impact Bethania took place. All opinions shared were well thought out and well-reasoned. The passion for Bethania that was expressed in many different ways was welcomed by myself. This passion provides me with hope for Bethania's future. It reaffirmed to me that our Congregation does care about Bethania's future; caring about that future like a parent cares about a child's future.

The vote concerning Pastor Allison was not unanimous nor did I think that it would be. There is much change that comes with a new chapter in Bethania's story. Our service time was a big part of the discussion over how Bethania will change. In November, Bethania's services on Sunday morning will be changing to 10:30 a.m. This change has been discussed at Bethania at least three times in my history on the Bethania Council and has come before the Congregation for a vote at a Congregational Meeting at least once in the past. Before, the discussion was whether a change in times would hopefully result in more members attending services. The later start was hoped to be more convenient for those members that need more time to get ready to leave the house in the morning. My recollection is that the vote to change the services failed to pass on a close vote; this happening about six or seven years ago.

The change in services is needed now for Pastor Allison to lead us in worship. She is currently the pastor at Journey in Faith Church on a 75% call. Pastor Allison leads Journey in Faith every Sunday in its 9 a.m. services. The **10:30 a.m.** start will allow her to comfortably arrive at Bethania on those days she leads our church in services. Bethania's agreement with Pastor Allison will be based on her serving the equivalent of a 20% call. (The percentage of call is based on a pay scale the time spent at the church is negotiated.) She is planning to serve Bethania's needs one day a week including office hours, one Sunday a month, and she will be leading Bethania's confirmation program.

Bethania currently has seven youth eligible for confirmation classes. I met with families for six of these young adults who expressed excitement over possibly having Pastor Allison lead confirmation. She was one of the pastors that partnered with Pastor Heather in Confirmation before COVID. In earlier talks with Pastor Allison, I was impressed that she could name all three of our confirmands from before COVID and expressed a sincere passion to help them complete their confirmation journey.

At the end of the Congregational Meeting, I asked for patience. With change comes times of feeling uncomfortable and unsure. That is only natural. I ask for patience as Bethania works through the upcoming changes and does its best to figure things out that we already see need figuring out. And, as we figure things out on those challenges that are not apparent now but always pop up.

Watch for Aebelskivers being offered at church on Sunday November 14 by Boy Scout Troop 242, and watch for announcements on a Thanksgiving meal at Bethania.



January 9, 2022




