Bethania has confirmation approaching where we can all celebrate in the maturing and growth of our youth. Advent is even being planned for now. Yes, the end of the year is approaching. At the latest Council Meeting, we used a guide from Synod to discuss where Bethania was at now, and where Bethania was going in the future. The discussion was honest and did not ignore the many limitations Bethania is experiencing at present. Such a conversation can create a feeling of frustration or gloom. Yes, we did talk about having fewer members in the pews and higher expenses. But I was struck at how the Council emphasized those things that happen at Bethania that we believe are important; that we believe are doing good for us and others; that make us feel proud of Bethania.

Not all of these things were the large efforts that Bethania is known for. The good **work of Thread By Thread was the first on everyone's lips as what we like about** Bethania in the community. We also clearly felt serving at the Community Meal site was an important accomplishment for Bethania. And of course continuing with LACE scholarships and grants was pointed to. But there was more good we saw in Bethania.

Smaller more personal things came up. Our openness in welcoming all to the altar for communion was mentioned. Or sharing life with our Church family was looked to as a source of support and happiness. The talent of our members such

as the Cares and Concerns team was pointed to. There are good things happening at Bethania and we should not let anyone look past that.

It was around this time last year that we held a Congregational Meeting that resulted in some tough decisions of how Bethania was going to continue worship coming out of COVID and led by a new pastor. Our annual Congregational Meeting is coming again near the end of January. I anticipate we, Bethania, will have another set of decisions to make for the coming year. In preparation for that, I would like to ask each member of Bethania to take some time to dwell on what it is at Bethania you like and what it is that you might want to change. If you would like to chat with me as your thoughts take shape, I would be more than happy to discuss at coffee hour or at a more quiet corner of the church if you like on Sundays.

Thank you to all the members of the Congregation hanging in there since we resumed in person services after our COVID closure. We have completed good work since then. The question we were asked by a supply pastor this time last year is still relevant. That question is "What would Christ want us to do?" If we can answer that and follow through, then Bethania will continue its good work into the future.




