want to thank everyone who was in on the surprise birthday celebration for me during July. It was very unexpected and also very touching. The cards were awesome. Some were funny, some were artistic, some were very original, and all were full of love and thoughtfulness. And then there was the cake and other goodies. Thank you again for cheering up my day in such a thoughtful manner.

By the time you read this, you will probably have noticed all kinds of painting activity happening around the church. For months, the Church Council has been looking into how to repaint and repair the window frames and trim on the upper levels of the church. Bids that were coming in were in the neighborhood of \$17,000 and \$18,000. This was a neighborhood that was too difficult for Bethania to move into. Recently, one of the painting companies followed up with Bethania indicating that business has been slowing. In order to keep their crews busy, the contractor offered Bethania a 25% "Production Gap" discount. This dropped the price to \$12,700 and brings the cost of painting to a neighborhood more attractive for Bethania. I would like to ask all in the Congregation to consider making a special gift to Bethania to help with covering the cost of the painting job. Any little bit will help with Bethania taking advantage of this special pricing.

On a different topic, I will be attending a meeting of the southern churches within the Milwaukee Synod before the end of August. I expect the topics to be discussed to include Pastoral vacancies, Pastoral Care, and other small parish concerns. If those issues are not on the agenda, I will be bringing them up on Bethania's behalf. I want to thank Pastor Allison for providing Bethania with a personal invite. For a meeting like this, it would be awful if Bethania was not in the know. Just in case anyone wasn't sure, Bethania has some very good friends that watch out for our Congregation. I will be sure to brief the Congregation on anything that comes of this meeting.

And finally, Summer continues to go by whether we are ready or not. On Sunday, September 10, Bethania once again is hosting the Community Meal Site at Living Faith Church. The entrée is on order and other menu items are being collected. If you would like to help in any way, just let Shelly or myself know at church. The latest we have heard is that the meals will still be assembled in take out containers with the patrons picking up their meals at the church's back door. Then on the following Sunday, we get to celebrate Bethania with a meal. A church picnic is planned with the church providing sandwiches. Please bring sides, salads, and deserts for all to enjoy. These potlucks have been very popular with those who have attended. If you have not had a chance to do so yet, circle the date on your calendar so that you can join in. The food has been plentiful and delicious. More importantly the fellowship has been loving and entertaining. Laughter and smiles were all around and not just due to having good food to eat. 
